## ART, CRAFT & DESIGN

The Art, Craft and Design (ACD) course offers students the opportunity to explore the varied aspects of fine art, design and craft.

Over the year, students develop and enhance basic skills in drawing and design and transfer these skills into other areas of study such as ceramics, painting and combined materials.

The student will finish the year with a comprehensive body of skills and a professional portfolio of work to use for third level applications.

Students may get the opportunity to travel abroad on the annual trip. Art Students will also take part in a graduate exhibition at the Dunamase Art Centre in Portlaoise.

Learners may be eligible to apply for a SUSI grant or a Back to Education Allowance. Funding supports may be available for jobseekers and others getting certain social welfare payments on all full-time courses.

## Progression Options

Learners who have satisfied the criteria set by the CAO process may progress to third level, and may secure a place in the National and Technological Universities on various Degree Programmes.
